PASSION FRUIT PRUNING CHEATSHEET

Best Time

- After harvest (when all fruit is picked)
- Late winter / earely spring before new growth starts

Tools

- Secateurs/pruning shears
- Gloves
- Disinfectant for tools

Steps

- 1. Inspect vine: Remove dead, diseased, or damaged
- Cut old wood: Remove stems older than 2 years and weak shoots
- Thin overcrowded growth: Improve airflow and sunlight penetration
- Shape the vine: Keep main framework branches shorten side shoots
- Cut correctly: Make cuts at 43-degree angle above a healthy node remove max 1/3 f. vine to avoid stress
- 6. Clean up debris Dispose away from plant
- 7. Aftercare: Mulch base
